All employees are responsible for ensuring that the environmental impact associated with our activities are identified and evaluated.

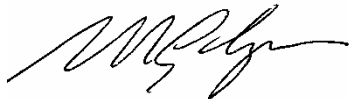
To prevent pollution and minimise our environmental impact L2 will:
